



Short facts of VIRTUS 2024 in Uppsala, Sweden

Location: Uppsala, Sweden. 30 km from Stockholm Arlanda Airport and 70km from Stockholm

Uppsala Friidrottsarena (the Competition venue)

Uppsala Friidrottsarena, the athletics stadium, opened in 2018 and is a modern top-level facility with high quality equipment for all events. The facility has a spectator capacity of approximately 4 000 people, a separate throwing field, numerous changing rooms and a kiosk serving food, snacks, and a variety of cold and warm drinks. The stadium has hosted several national and international championships at the youth and senior levels, with many excellent results, including the world leading men's discust throw by Daniel Ståhl in 2022, as a result.

Warm-up facilities in full-scaled indoor arena IFU Arena, only 100m from the competition venue.



IFU Arena

IFU Arena (the warm-up facilities) is located on Gränby Sports Ground, near the exit roads from the E4 and route 55 and with great public transport to and from the venue. Uppsala Friidrottsarena (the Competition venue), Gränby Ishallar (ice rinks), the Recoverhallen and UTK-hallen (racket sports) and Arenahotellet (the official hotel) are located on the same site.

IFU Arena is a top-level indoor athletics facility adjacent to the competition venue. The facility offers a 130 m straight runway, a gym, a 200-meter oval track, 3 long jump pits and offers great conditions for the vertical jumps as well as the throws. IFU Arena will serve as warm-up facilities during the championships.

IFU Arena also supplies meeting rooms, changing rooms and a popular restaurant serving a selection of healthy and well tasting lunch alternatives.

The athletics hall holds around 800 seats, and there is the option of erecting an additional gallery around the 200-metre track.

Capacity

The arena has a large restaurant available during events.

Local transport runs just outside, and there are numerous stops close to the arena. The arena also has 800 parking spaces.

A two-minute walk away is the hotel, Arenahotellet, with 200 rooms.

Arenahotellet will be the official team hotel during Virtus European Championships 2024. The hotel is located just next to the competition venue Uppsala Friidrottsarena, and indoor venue IFU Arena with training and warm-up facilities.

The hotel's largest conference room has space for around 200 persons, and sliding walls can be used to transform it into three smaller conference rooms. In addition, there are a further five conference rooms at various levels.

The 400 beds are secured at Arenahotellet for the dates of Virtus 2024



Travelling to and from Uppsala

As Stockholm Arlanda Airport is only 30 kilometres away, it's easy to get from the world to Uppsala and from Uppsala to the World.

Stockholm Arlanda Airport

In the middle of Scandinavia is Stockholm Arlanda Airport. This is the largest airport in Sweden, and is important for Uppsala, Uppland and the nearby regions. The airport has Sweden's most extensive route network, with more than 181 different national and international destinations.

Its proximity to Stockholm Arlanda Airport makes Uppsala an easily accessible destination for travelers from all over the world.

LOC Transfer Services


Transfers by bus will be included in the Team Package Fee and organized by LOC from Stockholm Arlanda Airport to Uppsala on arrival day, June 11th and from Uppsala to Stockholm Arlanda Airport on departure day, June 16th.

Travelling to Uppsala

For teams that prefer to arrive or depart outside the days when LOC organizes bus transfer, it's easy and convenient to get to Uppsala, with excellent rail connections to the airport.

Uppsala can be reached by train in only 17 minutes from Stockholm Arlanda Airport. To and from the airport you can comfortably travel onwards to Uppsala by direct train departing from SkyCity, between terminals 4 and 5. Trains depart twice an hour during the day.

Once arrived in Uppsala, local bus route 3 (direction Nyby) will take you from the Central Station to Lagerlöfsgatan in less than 15 minutes.





This is Uppsala

Uppsala is one of Sweden's oldest cities. It was known as Östra Aros up until the 13th century, when the name Uppsala took over. Today, Uppsala is one of Sweden's four major cities with a population of 240 000 inhabitants.

Uppsala has a rich and inspiring range of cultural activities and exciting events together with whole of Sweden's history – all in one place. The tourist attractions are numerous and exciting and include something for everyone. In addition, there is beautiful nature, both in the centre of town and close by. For travelers Uppsala is only 30 minutes away from Stockholm and 17 minutes from Stockholm Arlanda Airport by train. In the city the distances are short, and you can easily walk or bike to any sight or attraction.

Uppsala is today a modern city yet retains a small-town feel. It's Sweden's fourth largest city and home to two universities, the archbishopric of the Church of Sweden, a rich cultural life and beautiful scenery.
